<b>Acceptable days and times of arrival</b>	8 am - 8 pm daily
<b>Housing Address</b>	5451 Knobcone Loop Unit C Myrtle Beach, SC 29577
<b>Housing Costs</b>	Refundable deposit of \$500; rent cost is \$160 per week. You should pay your housing deposit before coming to the US to secure your spot.
<b>Housing Notes</b>	You will need to bring your own sheets, blanket, pillow, and towels.
<b>How to get to/from work and around the city</b>	Uber, Lyft or Taxi are always options but can become expensive. We advise getting a bicycle to get to/from work and around the community. There is a city bus system that runs occasionally.
<b>Location and person to report upon arrival</b>	First report to housing at 5451 Knobcone Loop Unit C, Myrtle Beach SC 29577. After paying your housing deposit, you will receive an email with the lockbox code to let yourself into the house. Do not report to the store, no one will be able to take you to the house.
<b>Arrival Airport</b>	MYR - Myrtle Beach International Airport
<b>How to get from the suggested airport to the check-in location</b>	Uber, Lyft or Taxi
<b>What to do if the arrival is outside of acceptable arrival date/times</b>	Get a hotel close to the airport and make arrangements for transportation the following day.
<b>Travel Notes</b>	<p>Plan ahead when booking your flight. Take note of the day and time of your departure and arrival.</p> <p>File any lost bag claims with the airline before leaving the airport. Be certain to get a receipt with a phone number.</p> <p>Transportation to your housing and any hotel accommodations is your financial responsibility.</p> <p>Directly communicate last minute changes in your arrival date/time and pre-departure health to your sponsor.</p> <p>You are required to travel with <b>at least \$1,000</b> for food, travel, and other expenses prior to your first pay check. You should consider traveling with more for any unexpected time periods where you may be out of work.</p>
